Dear Adults!

Welcome to KEF!

In Hebrew, Kef means fun. In Polish, KEF can also be the abbreviation for Kraina Edukacji i Fantazji (The Land of Education and Fantasy). Because, in this space, you can learn, have fun, and unleash your creativity all at once.

Our new permanent exhibition is aimed at children aged 6-12, but we hope that you will also have fun and learn something. The exhibition is divided into several themed sections, each of which contains information and tasks for you to complete.

1. SCRIPTURE

What is Torah? What does a Torah scroll look like? What is the job of a sofer, the person who transcribes the holy scrolls of Judaism, like?



Task: learn about the Hebrew alphabet and write your name using stamps or templates.

2. KRAKÓW'S KAZIMIERZ

Using the magnetic map of Kazimierz, you will get to know this unique district.



Task: put magnets on the map. These depict famous historical figures such as Moses Isserles, Sarah Scheiner, Ozjasz Thon, Róża Rock, Max Fleischer and Helena Rubinstein.

3. JEWISH SYMBOLS

What do the Star of David, lion, menorah and crown represent?



Task: choose a Jewish symbol and learn its meaning.

4. SYNAGOGUE

What is inside a synagogue? What do the words "bimah", "ner tamid" and "aron ha-kodesh" mean?



Task: put the models of synagogue furnishings on the right spots on the board.

5. JEWISH CALENDAR AND HOLIDAYS

What holidays are observed by Jews? What is so special about the Jewish calendar?



Task: spin the wheel, look inside the big book, and learn the names of the Jewish months and find out more about Jewish holidays.
